## **Association for Supportive Child Care**

Participants are eligible to receive a safety seat at no cost upon completion of a two (2) hour class. The two hour class offers information on the importance of using safety seats correctly, viewing a video, hands on activities and educational materials. To register for upcoming classes, call 480-829-0500 x 233.

After participants complete the 2 hour class, they must call (480-829-0500 x 233) to schedule an appointment to receive their car seat. To learn how to correctly install the car seat in their vehicle, participants will be working with a certified child passenger safety technician. Appointments are generally scheduled for the 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> Saturdays of the month and are made in the order in which calls were received.

Safety seats are distributed based on availability of funds.
